

ADMISSION POLICY

The students in Cadet College Karachi are inducted strictly on merit, subject to general conditions as follows:-

ELIGIBILITY:

Sons of the persons domiciled in the areas mentioned hereunder are entitled for admission, as per the quota specified against each: (60% in entry test is mandatory in all subjects)

(8) Wards of Shuhda (Army, CAF, Police of Sind Province Only)	05%

CLASS VIII

AGE & QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidate seeking admission must have passed Class VII, and should be between 12 to 14 years on 30th April of the year of admission.

Note: Relaxation of age on either side is NOT ALLOWED.

Minimum requirements for physical fitness of the candidates are:

a) HEIGHT 4" 10" (and not over 5"6")

b) WEIGHT 88 Lbs to 110 Lbs

c) CHEST 25" - 26" d) VISION Both eyes 6/6

e) JOINTS

There must be free and perfect motion of all joints.

f) Knee Knocking is an UNFIT case.

g) Complete FLAT-FOOT is medically unfit.

h) Permanent deformity of any part of the body is an unfit case.

I) No Positive Hepatitis (A,B OR C) case.

j) Any type of permanent alergy.

NOTE: The College medical board decision about medical fitness shall be treated as final and shall not be challenged in any court of law.

REGISTRATION AND AVAILABILITY OF FORMS

Registration of the candidates will be done when admission is announced in different national newspapers. Admission forms can be obtained from Cadet College Karachi and designated branches of advertised branches of banks.

SUBMISSION OF FORMS:

Forms duly completed in all aspects be submitted along with documents and should be sent directly to the CADET COLLEGE KARACHI' Education City near Darsano Chano, Memon Goth Road Malir, Karachi clearly marked on the top right corner ADMISSION FOR CLASS VIII / XI (whichever is applicable). After scrutinization, only eligible candidates are allotted roll numbers for subsequent tests / interview and medical tests.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The selection is based on the performance / grading of a candidate in the following:-

- a. Written Test
- b. Medical Examination at CMH Malir Cantt
- c. Interview
- d. Final merit list by selection committee

WRITTEN TEST:

- 1. Written test will be held after the scruitny of all provided documents by the candidate and the date of written test will be intimated through phone call / SMS
- 2. If an admission form is rejected due to any reason, it can not be challenged in any court of law or forum.
- 3. In case of rejection of a form prospectus fee will not be refunded.

SYLLABUS FOR WRITTEN TEST

FOR CLASS VIII:

Written test for Class VIII is taken from Sindh Text Book Board syllabus for Class VI and VII in following subjects:

- (a) English
- (b) Mathematics and General Science
- (c) Urdu and Islamiat (Pakistan Studies for Non- Muslim)
- (d) General Knowledge and Intelligence Test

FOR CLASS XI:

Wrijtten Test for Class XI is taken from books of classes IX and X from Sindh Board . The test of following subjects will be conducted

English, Urdu, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Gen Knowledge, Islamiat & Computer (only for Computer Science).

Those who qualify written test, are individually intimated and called for medical examination followed by interview.

Those who qualify all stages of the Entrance Test are placed on merit list drawn according to their performance. The final selection will be based on the merit list. The call-up letters for joining the college are then issued and the selectees will join on the specified date.

Note: The final merit list will be uploaded on College's website www.cckarachi.edu.pk
The college will admit no liability for delay / non-delivery / loss etc, of the communication due to postal system's fault.

UNIFORM / CLOTHING

Cadets wear the following dress on different occasions:

- a) Khaki Uniform: Khaki uniform of Army pattern is worn during classes, parade and drill.
- b) MUFTI: College Mufti for the respective seasons is to be put on by all cadets. The same is to be used during preps, meals and visit / going outside the college campus.
- c) Games & P.T: College shorts/trousers, vests and P.T shoes are to be used during games and P.T.
- d) Prayer Dress: Shalwar / Qameez with black waist coat and black shoes or Peshawari chappal can be used for all prayers. During winter, jersey pull-over or sweater/blazer will be used.

OUANTITY

CURRICILUM

The College year is divided into terms as under:-

- A) 1st Term- From April to September.
- B) 2nd Term- From October to January.
- C) 3rd Term- From February to March.

EXAMINATION

The curriculum for all classes, excluding class VIII, is based on syllabus prescribed by the Sindh Text Book Board. The subjects taught in the college are Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Computer, Islamiat, Akhlaqiyat (only for Non-Muslims), English, Urdu Sindhi, and Pak studies.

ASSESSMENT / EVALUATION

The process of academic evaluation and personality assessment is carried out round the year, through terminal bi-monthly tests / terminal tests / annual examinations and various activities and exercises organized in the College.

WITHDRAWALS

A cadet can be withdrawn from the college owing to his poor performance in the Board as per details below:

Class VIII: If he is unable to get minimum 60% marks in all subjects.

Class IX to XII: In case of preliminary examination of Class IX to XII, and the Board exam, cadet's failure even in one subject will result in his withdrawal and also if he is unable to get 60% marks in board exam (even passed in all subjects) will result in his withdrawal.

NOTE: There will be no compromise on withdrawal criteria.

LABORATORIES

For effective teaching of science, the practicals are carried out in well-equipped and furnished Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Computer laboratories. Modern labs help the students in conducting their practicals as required by the examination boards. Qualified teachers and lab assistants render help to the students.



LIBRARY

Well-equipped library provides meaningful education for all cadets. College library is upgraded from time to time. Proper library periods are held where class teachers with qualified librarian help the students to choose the books. Reference books also provide help in doing the project work and assignments.



RELIGIOUS TRAINING

For religious and ideological orientation of the cadets, various activities are carried out regularly i.e Nazra Quran, teaching of Namaz and Islamic Quiz in addition to five time prayers.



PHYSICAL TRAINING AND SPORTS

Physical training is an important feature of the college routine. Training is imparted by qualified instructors. The College has got playing facilities for all major games like Cricket, Football, Hockey, basketball, Table Tanis, Volleyball, Squash, Badminton and Athletics. A Swimming Pool of international standard and a stable for horse riding are also available.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular / Extra curricular activities are part and parcel of education. For balanced development of personalities of the students and to groom them appropriately for the future, a wholesome package of activities is planned and Inter-House Debate competition, Inter-House Quiz competition, Inter-House Naat and Qira'at. Seerat Quiz, Poster making and numerous other competitions are organized throughout the year.







DAILY ROUTIONE

All the activities in the college are carried out according to carefully designed daily routine, which covers the activities of cadets from the time they rise early in the morning till they go to the bed at night.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

A Calendar of events showing all the details of vacations/ holidays, in addition to schedule of curricular and co-curricular events, organized throughout the year is published and issued to all the cadets and their parents / guardians at the beginning of each session. All efforts are made to observe holidays / vacations, events, exams, PTM, Competitions indicated in the college Calendar of year.



PTM (PARENTS TEACHER MEETING)

To keep the parents informed of their sons' academic progress and to discuss the cadets' achievements / deficiencies, parent- teacher meetings (PTM) are convened regularly.



PARENTS' VISIT TO THE COLLEGE

The cadets joining this institution would, naturally, take some time to adjust themselves to the new atmosphere of the College. The shorter the visits of the parents, the better the cadets will adjust themselves to the new environment. It will, therefore, be in the interest of cadets as well as of the College that the parents restrict their visits to the college to the minimum unless it is unavoidable.











PROHIBITED ITEMS

Cadets are not permitted to keep the following:-

- 1) Any type of weapon.
- 2) Cigarettes, narcotics in any form, matches, burners, heaters.
- 3) Explosive, combustible material.
- 4) Wireless Radio, TV set, Walkman, iPad, Personal Computer, Laptop, Cellular / Mobile phone, Video Camera etc.
- 5) Transistors, Video Games or any other electrical appliances.
- 6) Unauthorized Medicines / Drugs.
- 7) Unauthorized pattern of clothes, shoes etc.
- 8) Dry fruit.
- 9) Chalia, Gutka, Paan, Naswar, Alcoholic items etc.
- 10) Animals (pets etc).
- 11) Any other items decided by College Administration.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Upon admission to College, each cadet and his parents will automatically bind themselves to abide by the college rules / regulations and orders. Penalties for infringement shall be at the sole discretion of the Principal. These shall not be questioned under any circumstances. Admission will only be confirmed on the implicit understanding that these conditions are acceptable to the applicant and his parents / guardian.

TELEPHONE CALLS

According to college policy cadets will contact to their parents on every Sunday from 1100 to 1600 hrs. If any emergency call is to be made on any other day, the parents are advised to contact the respective House Master.

ACCIDENT / MISHAPS

The college will adopt all possible measures for the safety of the cadets during their stay in the college campus. However, the College shall not be responsible for any kind of accident / mishaps causing any physical harm or injury.

Note: Migration fee, enrollment fee and examination fee are not included, these to be paid by respective parents

- **2.** The consolidated fee mentioned above includes tuition fee, lodging ,boarding, laundry, Sports, first aid medical treatment (inside college), library contribution, hair-cut, shoe repair, gym, swimming and riding. All efforts are made to hire best faculty, quality food for messing and the best services / facilities and living conditions. Annual increase in fees hence, is a natural phenomenon and under compulsion, the fees are raised @ 5 % every year according to the prevailing rate of inflation and general dearness in cost of goods and services provided.
- **3.** Total amount will be deposited at the start of every session.

4. MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES:

In addition to the above, the cadets shall have to pay actual charges for clothing, books and stationery, beddings and outdoor medical treatment, outdoor excursion trips.

5. PROCEDURE FOR PAYMENT OF FEES:

Payments shall be made through bank fee voucher of Cadet College Karachi. No other mode of payment is acceptable. For subsequent payments, GR number, name and house of the cadet must be clearly mentioned in the covering letter. All the fee, including admission fee will be paid in full (No installments) in the beginning of the year (Full fee is charged for vacation period also) However, feeding charges are not collected for the duration of summer vacations.

6. COLLEGE LEAVING CERTIFICATE

The students seeking admission in this college are expected to stay in the institution till they appear at the final stage (HSC PART -II) exam therefore, the cadets asking for school leaving certificate/ migration before completion of their F.Sc, shall have to pay discontinuation fine of Rs.25000/- and full fees for the current session / year in which the cadets apply for discontinuation. However if applied with in 1 month, only 50% of the consolidated fee will be refunded. Any kind of refund is expected to be processed to GoS with in 45 days of submission of application.

7. ON TERMINATION:

On termination of cadets from the college, yearly fee and all other charges will not be paid back to the parents / guardians.

NOTE: All dues are to be paid in advance through a bank draft in favor of 'PRINCIPAL CADET COLLEGE KARACHI'.





FACILITIES

ACADEMIC FACILITIES

College has separate academic wings. The classrooms are well designed for better learning environment. Well-equipped Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology and Computer laboratories are in practice.

CLUBS

A number of hobbies and clubs are being promoted at the college to channelize the talent of cadets in useful pursuits, these include Science, Drama, and Debating. Extra fee is payable for joining some of the clubs and hobbies.





HOSTELS

There are five hostels at the campus. Cadets are divided in four different Houses, named after the great presonalities of national and regional importance, i.e. Jinnah House, Iqbal House, Latif House and Shahbaz House. A Housemaster, assisted by Hostel Incharg and other attendants manages each house as per college rules and regulations. This team is responsible to prepare the cadets for Inter- House competitions in all three dimensions, i.e. academic, sports and co-curricular activities.





MESS

Mess for cadets in two magnificent buildings is situated adjacent to the Hostels' area. The Mess functions under the supervision of Administration and senior members of the teaching staff. Cadets are also associated with the management of the Mess, they are responsible to suggest the menu and discuss ways and means of improving the mess standard with the members of teaching staff.





MEDICAL FACILITIES

A qualified doctor and competent staff are available for cadets for minor daily treatment. If required, cadets are referred to specialists or surgeons of Combined Military Hospital (CMH) Malir as per requirements. The expenses for such consultation / treatment will be borne by the parents.

RECRATION

Besides sports, games, hobbies and co-curricular activities, the cadets have been provided with TV and libraries for leisure hours. There is also a recreation club which arranges screening of selected English movies on weekends periodically. Excursion trips, variety programs, dramas and many other activities are also organized from time to time.

SERVICES PRESENTATION (IN PROCESS)

Pakistan Army has provided military staff for parade, military, physical and leadership training. The team is headed by an adjutant. The military staff is responsible for maintaining discipline.



DATA PROCESSING CELL (DPC)

Data processing cell is established to provide support to the institution's administration and to facilitate the students, the parents and the staff. DPC maintains the following:

- a) Website of the institution
- b) Local Area Network for offices.
- c) Student information and evaluation system.
- d) Human resource attendance and evaluation system
- e) SMS-based notification delivery system.
- f) Centralized data library.
- g) Teachers evaluation system.

























TERMINATION POLICY

The college administration reserves the right to strike off the name of a student from the college roll. Following offences will render a student liable to withdrawl / expulsion from the college with or without warning depending upon the gravity of offence:

- a) Indiscipline, cheating, stealing or immoral conduct.
- b) Disobeying and rudeness to staff.
- c) Being habitually untidy and neglecting college orders..
- d) Willfully damaging the college property.
- e) Keeping prohibited items (already referred before).
- f) Possessing mobile phones, arms, fire-arms, knives or any other lethal weapons.
- g) Showing consistently poor performance in academics.
- h) Leaving the college premises without proper permission.
- I) Fighting with other students.
- j) Smoking or use of drugs of any sort.
- k) Use of abusive language.
- 1) Inviting outside elements to settle the score with fellow students.
- m) Chalking on the walls or in washrooms.
- n) Non-payment of dues within specific dates.
- o) Misbehavior / misconduct and rudeness of the students or their parents / guardians.
- p) Student who fails in the board exam or failing to achieve 60% marks in Board exam.
- q) Prolonged absence without leave (Maximum up to 10 days).
- r) Sensational manipulation with other students.
- s) Spreading immoral and indiscipline behavior amongst the students.
- t) Involvement in students grouping or students union.
- u) Use of unfair means in tests / examination, even assisting others in it.
- v) Refusal of correction, minor punishment ordered by extra drill / PT or academic staff or military staff.
- w) Tarnishing the image of college or staff by cadets or their parents through any means of communication.
- x) Using medicines other than those prescribed by college MO or a specialist doctor at CMH Malir Cantt, Karachi.
- y) Pressurizing or threatening of staff by parents / guardians through courts.
- z) Any other offence considered to be serious enough by the college authorities.
- aa) Having excess money (max limit Rs 1000/-), valuables like gold / silver chains, rings etc.
- bb) Keeping transistor radio, tape recorder, mobile phone, video games, CD / VCD / DVD player, any electrical appliances, musical keyboard etc.

RETENTION POLICY

CLASS VIII

- (a) A student who secures less than 60% marks in any subject in Final Term Exam will be failed.
- (b) A student who fails in any subject may be retained in the same class.
- Any student who fails to meet the promotion criteria may be retained in the same class.
- (d) A student who fails to qualify for promotion in two consecutive academic years will be withdrawn from Cadet College Karachi.

CLASS IX to XII

Cadet's failure even in one subject, in case of Send Up / Pre-Board examination of Class IX to XII and the Board exam, may result in withdrawal.

LEAVE POLICY

- a) Cadets will be allowed to go home for maximum three days on sudden death of their father, mother, real brother or real sister (not for any other relative).
- **b)** For wedding ceremony of real brother and real sister, parents are requested to please schedule their wedding ceremony according to the off days mentioned in Calendar of Year of Cadet College Karachi. There will be no leave for wedding ceremony of any relative during session.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTION

Any disinformation from the parents on social media regarding the institution, teaching staff or administration of Cadet College Karachi, may result in their ward's termination from the College, with or without warning depending upon the gravity of the blame.

SOP FOR LATE ARRIVING CADETS

1. The following punishments be awarded to a cadet, if he comes late, or absents himself on the expiry of leave or long leave vacation:

a. Late arrival by over one hour : a fine of Rs. 200/- per hour

b. Absence for one day : a fine of Rs. 1000/-

c. Absence for subsequent up to : a fine of Rs. 1000/- per day maximum of ten days

- 2. The name of cadet will be struck off the college rolls after 10 days unauthorized absence, without any further notice.
- 3. Warning letter will be issued on subsequent 02 days late arrival after a long weekend or vacation. If three warning letters are issued to a cadet, his name will be struck off the college rolls.
- 4. In case of illness or accident during leave or vacation, medical certificate must be submitted with necessary medical reports duly verified from any CMH. In case of failure to do this the above mentioned penalties may be applied.
- 5. If a cadet is unable to join upto 20 days due to serious illness he will be reverted to previous class.
